Medical Issues

We have been notified about a case of **chicken- pox** in school so please be vigilant. It usually begins with the onset of a slight fever, feeling generally unwell for a couple of days before the spots appear, usually on the scalp/face and back. This is highly infectious during its early stages from one or two days before until five days after the spots first appear. If your child does contract chicken-

pox they should be kept home from school until as least 5 days from onset of the rash and not developing new lesions.

We have also been informed of a case of **head lice.** Again, please be vigilant. No exclusion from school is necessary

but if any signs of lice are found please treat the whole family, either by wet combing with plenty of cheap conditioner or by using a lotion from the chemist.
