Flu immunisation - Nasal flu immunisations take place on Wednesday, 29 November for pupils in Reception, and Y 1, 2, 3 and 4.

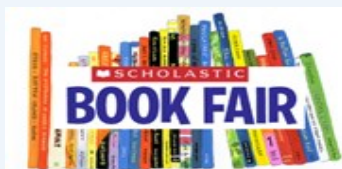

£3.00 inc breakfast and £2.00 childcare only

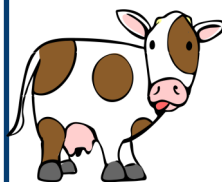
There's no need to book unless you require breakfast.
