Playscript: The kitchen scene

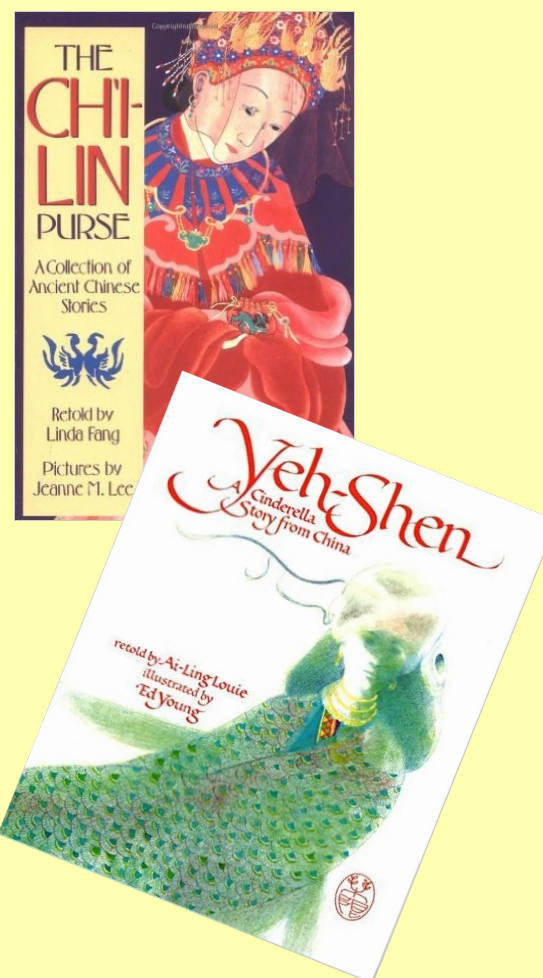
- ◇ Punctuation especially colons, dashes and brackets
