Numeracy:

During this term we will be learning about; number and place value - reading and writing numbers accurately.

Mental addition and subtraction within 20, calculation, number bonds, mental and written +/-, geometry- properties of 2D/3D shapes, time and problem solving/reasoning.

All areas are covered throughout the year will be consolidated and developed further.

Literacy:

Children will be read a range of superhero stories and watch clips from appropriate superhero films to develop a range of vocabulary, to describe each hero.

We will look at sentence structure e.g beginning. Middle and end, written in the correct order (once upon a time and basic conjunctions

Children will learn how to use basic descriptive language, punctuate sentences using capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.

Our focus is handwriting, spelling and reading to extend children's understanding of words and develop their fluency.

Music:

During this term Children will use their voices expressively and experiment will sounds as well as being able to recognise long and short sounds.

We will also experiment with a selection of musical instruments.



Art and Design:

The children will use a range of materials creatively to design and make products as well as using a wide range of art and design techniques.

Design and Technology:

We will be using a range of materials creatively to design and make products linked to our topic.

RE:

The children will be read stories from the Bible and learn about beliefs and values.

Geography:

Children will learning about the 7 continents and 5 Oceans.

They will identify locations of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
