Numeracy:

Children's learning will include a range of practical activities and during this term they will be learning about; number and place value - reading and writing numbers accurately, mental addition and subtraction, calculation number bonds, mental and written +/-, geometry-properties of 2D/3D shapes, position and direction and problem solving and reasoning.

Literacy:

In literacy we will be learning the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. Children will create their own story maps and write their own stories.

We will look at sentence structure e.g beginning. Middle and end, written in the correct order (once upon a time and basic conjunctions). Children will learn how to punctuate sentences using capital letters, full stops, question marks and

exclamation marks. We will practicing handwriting daily, as well as reading to extend children's understanding of words and develop their fluency.

Science: - Human Facts

Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense







RE: Hinduism/ Christianity


We will be looking at Diwali (the festival of lights), this half term and children will be looking at the similarities and differences between Christianity and Hinduism.
