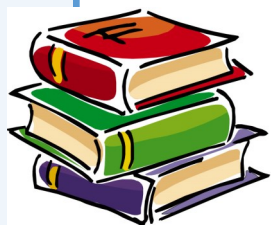

Don't forget that our Breakfast Club is open daily from 8.00 am- 8.40 am

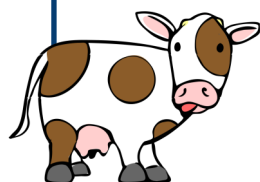
Cost remains the same as last year:

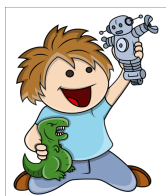
School Milk. If you would like your child to receive milk at breaktimes please visit www.coolmilk.com to register your child. Milk is free for under 5s.
