- ◇ Use a wide range of sentence structures (i.e. be able to move sub-ordinate clause around the sentences)

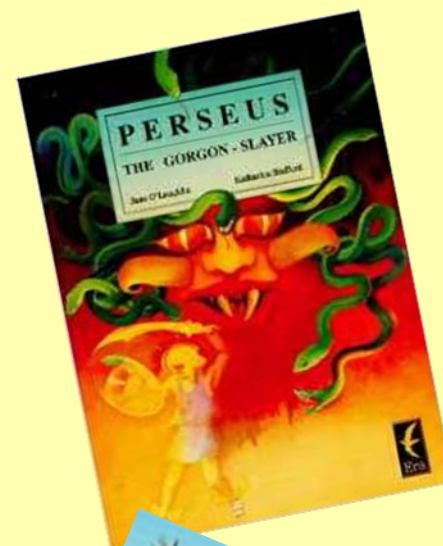
As mathematicians we will learn about:
