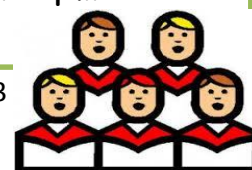
Child starting school?

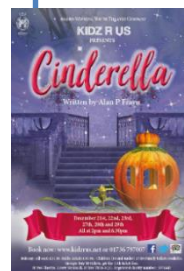
Treen Class – Please can ALL children in Treen class return their library books so that they can be exchanged for new ones regularly.
