## Let's Celebrate & Night and Day

### Literacy

Listen and respond to stories about light and dark, then Christmas stories.

Retrieve facts about space and space travel from information books.

Blend sounds in words to read simple sentences and segment to spell and write words.

Read and write tricky words.

### Mathematics

Recognise and order numbers to 10 and beyond.

Recognise coins and their values.

Know the days of the week and o'clock times.

Recognise 2D shapes.

Solve problems involving doubling and sharing.

Daily counting activities will support number and counting practise.

## Specific Areas

### Understanding the World

Talk about similarities and differences between day and and night.

Talk about what it might be like to visit space, what would you see?

Use I pads and computers to complete simple programs on the space theme.

Talk about Christmas traditions and celebrations.

### Expressive Arts & Design

Introduce a storyline into role play with others, using props.

Experiment with a range of materials to create day and night pictures.

Explore what happens when you mix colours.
