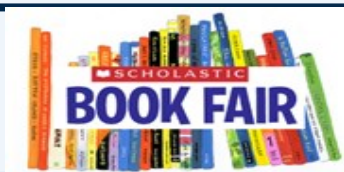

£3.00 inc breakfast and £2.00 childcare only

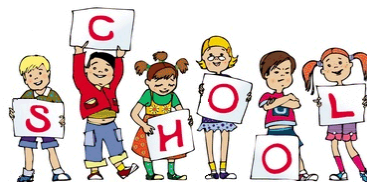

Violin lessons

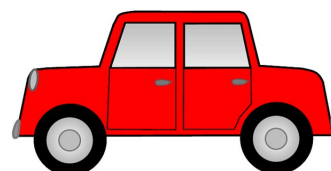
We can now offer violin lessons. If your child is interested in learning please let us know.
