Don't forget that our Breakfast Club is open daily from **8.00 am- 8.40 am**

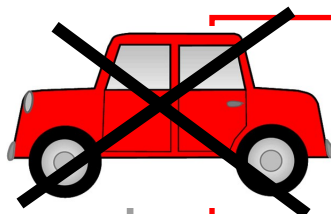
Cost remains the same as last year:
