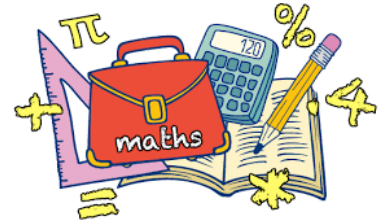




St Erth Primary School Maths Marking Policy



- ✓ Mark correct answers with a tick.
- Incorrect answers to be marked by a dot.
- S Work that has been completed with support.
- I Work that has been completed independently.
- VF Discussion with a teacher/TA has taken place. This may be accompanied by a brief description of what has been discussed.
- SC This can be used when children have been made aware of mistakes and have looked again at their work without assistance from T/TA.

The learning objective for the lesson is placed in the children's books and these will be highlighted to indicate the level that children have been working at.

Pink will be used to indicate that the child is working towards the learning objective.

Orange will be used to indicate that the learning objective has mostly been achieved.

Green will be used to indicate that learning objective has been securely achieved.

Blue will indicate that the learning objective has been achieved and greater depth has been demonstrated.

Green pen = Live marking at the time with the children present.

Red Pen = Marking completed later on without the child present.

MOT = Maths On Track. Children not achieving the learning objective will be given extra support in class MOT time. This will be identified by an MOT stamp/sticker and date, alongside the initials of the adult who worked with the child.
