SCHOOL MILK

We are sending home leaflets regarding the School Milk scheme with those children who do not already have milk and have ex-



pressed an interest in having it. If you would like for this to happen please register your child on line with the company. If you child is under 5 they will receive this free until their 5th birthday. If your child has free school meals (not universal infant free school meals) the school will automatically register them and pay for their milk.



Cinema - Don't forget that on Monday we are visiting the cinema for a post-Christmas treat. You will need to deliver children to the church so please arrive by 8.50 am as we will leave promptly at 9 am and will need to call registers first. Please just drop your children off and leave as there

will be very little room for extra vehicles. Children must bring a coat as they will have to walk back to school from the church after the trip.
