FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND PUPIL PREMIUM

Do you think your circumstances might entitle you to free school meals for your child? Even if they already receive Universal Infant Free School Meals, please make an application as this will also entitle your child to Pupil Premium funding. This extra funding will last for at least 6 years, regardless of changes to your circumstances, and will provide extra money for the school to use to support your child and also some money for you to allocate for trips, etc, as you see fit. 
