Remote Learning

We would like to make all parents aware that the legal requirement for schools to provide remote learning whilst children are off school with Covid or any other illness has been removed. As a result we have stood down our remote learning policy. Therefore teachers will not be planning work and communicating regarding this with parents whilst children are off school. However, all pupils have a log in for Doodle Maths and Reading Eggs. These will provide good skills development during any period of absence. It is also essential to remember that any reading children do is always beneficial to them. Where children are unable to attend school for an extended period of time the school will work with parents to provide appropriate support.

The School Day

This year we have maintained a slight staggered start and end to the day as Covid recovery continued. With all Covid restrictions being lifted we are now in a position to put firmer timings to the start and end of the school day. They are as follows:

8:45 - gates open

8:50 - registers are taken

9:00 - registers close

9:00 - the 1st lesson of the day begins

3:10 - Treen and Mousehole class finish

3:15 - Fistral and Godrevy class finish

We are grateful for your support in helping us keep to these timings. It is essential that children are in school on time to make the most of their learning day. Teachers have early work set up as soon as children get in. During this time they revise key skills which helps them to feel prepared for the day's lessons. Arriving at 9:00 for a week results in children missing 1 hour and 15 minutes of learning over the week. Over a term this is a very significant amount of learning time lost that can't be recovered.
