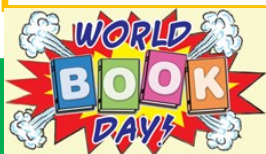

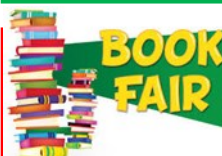


### SPONSORED READ - 1st March—8th March

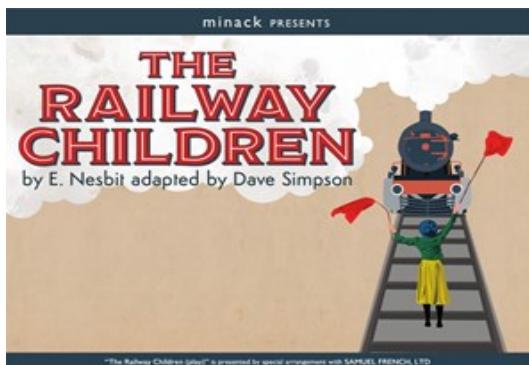
Please help us enhance our library, by encouraging your child to read every day or be read to. They can read books, comics, menus, websites, instructions etc.
