Twinkl sets out the curriculum and has loads of resources and links so if there is something you are unsure of, click on the resources and read up on what it means.

I hope this is useful as gives everyone the opportunity to become confident in the year groups you work with. Lots of the resources are free to download so if you find an activity you think will help when working with groups, download and save ready for when we are back in school!

Here's what to do:

- Make a personal Twinkl account by signing up – it's free. [www.twinkl.co.uk](http://www.twinkl.co.uk)
