EASTER HOLIDAY MULT-SPORTS CAMPS

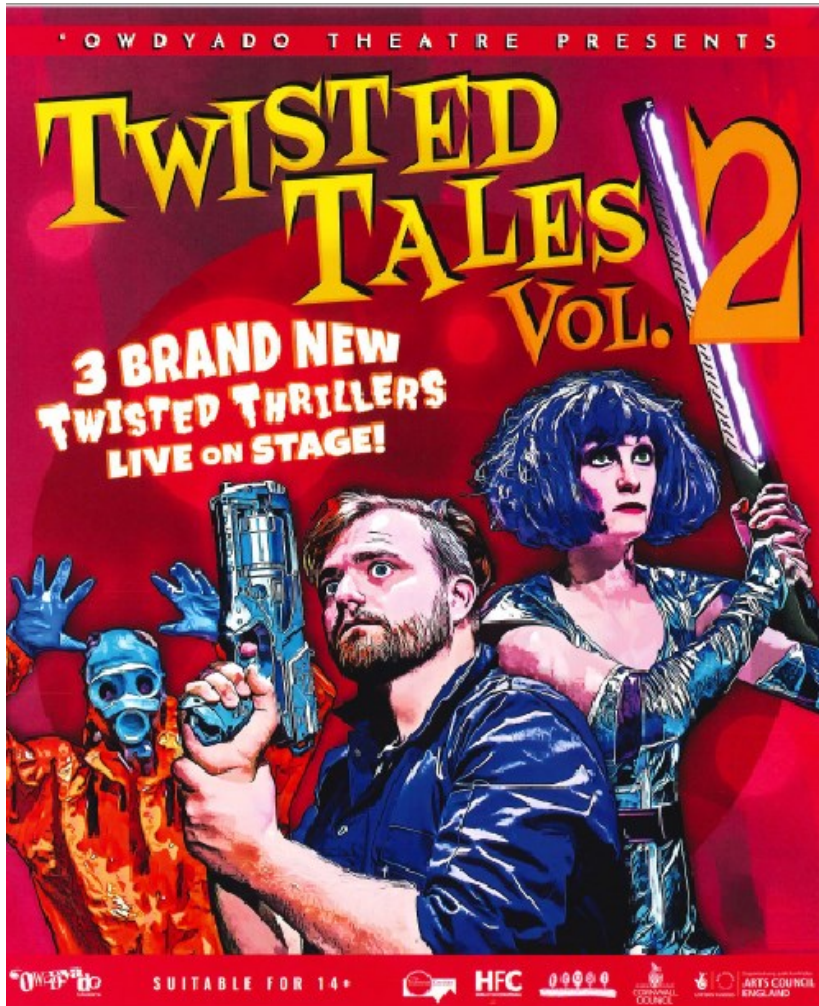
