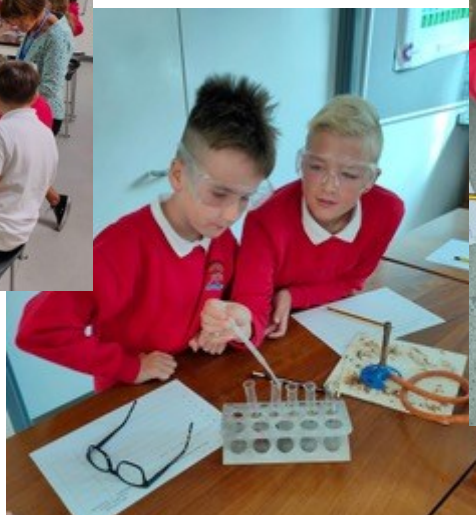

Clubs

Hayle Academy Open Day - This takes place next Wednesday for Year 6 pupils and children were given a letter about this earlier in the week. Both a snack for break time and lunch will be provided. The school will transport the children both ways. Please make sure they arrive on time on Wednesday.

Parking outside School

A few requests from us at school to do with parking.

1. **Please do not park between the yellow school lines and the new speed bump.** On several occasions this has caused the road to be blocked. We have been in touch with the Parish Council and will be requesting the yellow lines are extended to the speed bump. Their purpose is to ensure emergency access at all times. In addition to this please do not park close to the bump on the other side to ensure access at all times.
2. If you are parking on school road, please ensure you are not parked on the opposite side to another parked car. It is a narrow road and again this prevents access.
3. If you are parking in Boscarnek, please ensure you do not park over the lowered curbs at the entrance. This will cause crossing in blind spots and we have and near misses with children as a result.
4. Please respect our neighbours opposite by not turning in their driveway.
5. Please avoid turning in the road. Cars overhanging curbs and pavements at busy times have been an issue in the past.

We know that parking is not ideal and that recent traffic calming measures have caused some frustration. Thank you to all of our parents for parking considerably and looking out for one another by raising these issues with the school. They have also been shared with St Erth Nursery.

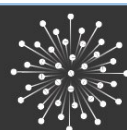
School Admissions

If your child was born between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019 you will need to make an application by 15 January 2023.

If your child is in Year 6 you will need to make an application for a place at secondary school by 31 October 2022.
