Cricket Tournament


The children who took part in the cricket tournament on Thursday had a wonderful time. Many boundaries were hit and we have some future stars in our midst.

Cookery Club - There are still some members of the current cookery club who have not paid their £10 towards the cost of ingredients. Please try and send this on Monday.




