# **CAMP KERNOW**

This is taking place on Tuesday and Wednesday next week. Children were given a final reminder letter earlier this week. Children should come to school as normal on Tuesday, bringing all the camp things with them (they don't need to wear uniform). They will leave here shortly after 9 am and return to school mid afternoon on Wednesday for collection at the normal time. Please make sure that children have enough warm clothing for the night as the temperatures are set to drop in the next few days.

Any medication that your child needs, including inhalers, should be sent from home. This must be clearly labelled with your child's name. Please write out full and clear instructions for the administration of the medicine, which must include the medication name, dosage, etc, and be signed by you. These should be given direct to the teacher before departure. If your child needs to take a travel sickness pill this should be administered to them before arriving at school and the return journey pill should be labelled as other medicines (see above) and given to the teacher.

Don't forget that children need a packed lunch on Tuesday. This will need to be sent from home as our cook will not be in school on Monday to prepare them. THEY MUST ALSO BRING A WA-TER BOTTLE.

#### **PARKING**

Please remember that, for safety reasons, the car park should not be used during busy times, when children are arriving or leaving school.

Please also be mindful when parking outside school that you leave plenty of clear space to allow children to cross the road safely, ensuring that they can see and be seen. Finally, do limit your speed around the school at busy times as we have recently had a near miss.
