**CLASS PHOTOS** - Don't forget that the deadline for ordering class photos through the school is on Monday. If you miss this you can still order direct with Tempest.

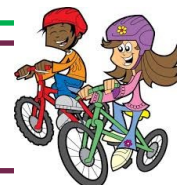
### MARY POPPINS
