### School diary dates

Today, along with your newsletter you will receive a list of all the significant diary dates we have for this term. <u>School Meals -</u> Thursday is School Census day when we encourage pupils to have a school meal as the number taken on that day affects our funding. The children will be able to 'build their own burger', choosing either a meat or veggie burger and 3 toppings, served with chips and beans.



Don't forget that the price of school meals has increased to £2.41 per meal.

#### DEBTS

Debts this week total just under £400. A portion of these relates to school meals. Please remember that all school meals should be paid for in advance or on the day the meal is taken. A reminder to Year 3 children parents that Universal Free School Meals only applies up to Year 2 so if your child has just gone into Year 3 any meals taken this term need to be paid for.



Our Breakfast Club starts at 8 am each morning if you need to get to work early.. It costs £2.00 per

session and there's no need to book unless your child needs a breakfast as well as childcare. In this case we do need to know the day before and breakfast costs an extra £1 per day. The club is free for those in receipt of Pupil Premium funding.
