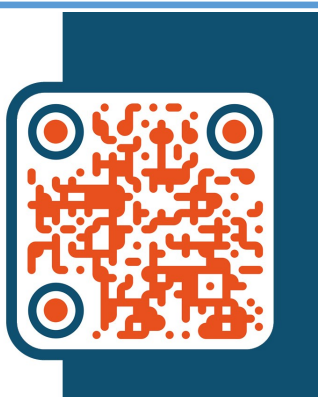

**Covid Guidance** - Your child should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people if they have symptoms of COVID-19 and they either have a high temperature and/or do not feel well enough to go to school, college or childcare, or do their normal activities.

They can go back to school, when they feel better or do not have a high temperature.

If your child has mild symptoms such as a runny nose, sore throat or mild cough, and they feel well enough and don't have a temperature, they can go to school, college or childcare.
