During the informal Q&A session at the end of the presentation, Richard will be happy to stay online for as much time as needed to help address any of your individual questions and comments.

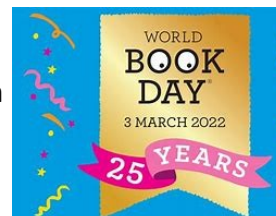

Updated Coronavirus Guidance -

Following the recent Government updates to national Covid guidance, please be aware that at present nothing has changed here in school. As soon as our Risk Assessment is updated we will let you know. In the meantime, guidance remains as follows:

- Book a PCR test for anyone in your household who develops Covid symptoms.
- Anyone who is notified that they are a close contact of a positive case should take a lateral flow test daily for 7 days. They do not need to isolate unless they develop symptoms, in which case they should book a PCR test.
- Please limit social contact as much as you can to reduce the spread of the virus.
